Database Highlights

Starting this month, we will be highlighting features of the different databases found on our website. This month we will be focusing on **ePrep**.

ePrep is a database designed to help students prepare for ACT, PLAN, SAT, and PSAT exams. The courses presented are student-adaptable, monitoring students' progress throughout the lessons. **ePrep's** Study Hall feature links subject and strategy videos to missed or skipped questions for review. With **ePrep**, the student will set up a study schedule, identifying the number of exams and test dates for each subject. The database allows the student to set up email notifications to keep them on schedule. When it is time to take a practice exam, the student gets the "test day experience" – allowing the time and space for the exam. Exam scores are given immediately. It is then recommended that the missed questions be reviewed with the auditory and video instructions. There are many tricks and buttons on **ePrep** to support the learning process, including the "?" for help on any page you are on.
